

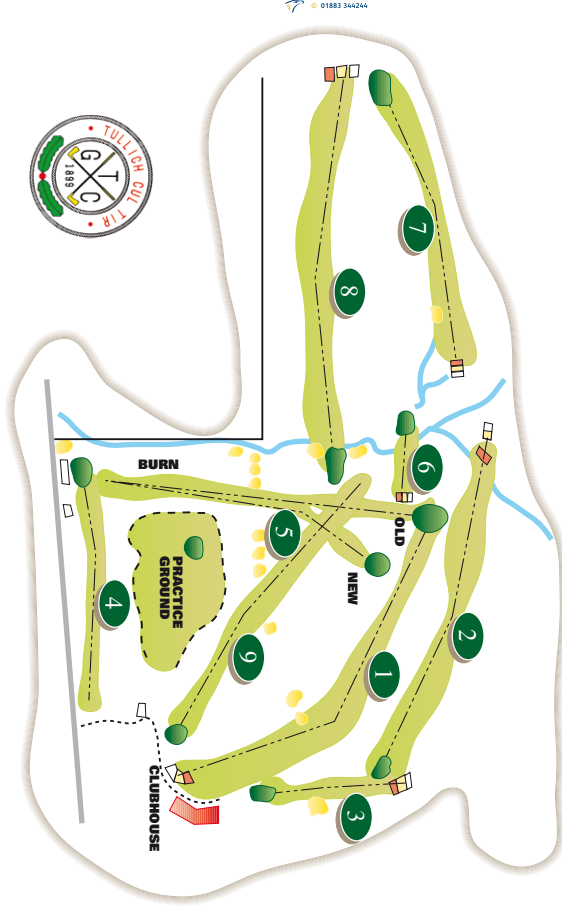

TILlicOUNTRY GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

A ball shall be out of bounds if it comes to rest in the Car Park or beyond the white posts in front of the Clubhouse or any boundary wall, fence or boundary marker. The garden area marked to the right of the 9th green/1st tee is out of bounds.

The area within the greenkeepers' yard.

2. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

(Note exceptions Rule 24-2(b))

The sign posts on the left of the 4th fairway, the balls at the 6th and 15th tee, the garden on the right 1st tee, the fence around the 1st tee and in front of the Clubhouse, the greenkeepers' workshop, the Junior Clubhouse, all internal marker posts (not boundary posts), all bench seats and staked trees.

3. PATHS

A ball coming to rest on a path must be lifted and dropped one club-length from the path at the nearest point of relief but not nearer the hole.

Tractor path behind 2nd green a ball coming to rest on tractor path lift and drop at nearest point of relief not nearer hole.

4. WATER HAZARD (Rule 26)

The burn is a water hazard defined by yellow and red (lateral) marker posts.

5. PRACTICE AREA

A ball coming to rest within the practice area must be lifted and dropped one club-length out of the practice area at nearest point but not nearer the hole.

6. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

All newly turfed or seeded areas (with the exception of seeded divots) or other ground so marked **GUR**.

7. STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

8. MOBILE TELEPHONES

The use of mobile telephones is prohibited on the course.

9. USE OF PRACTICE AREA ON COMPETITION DAYS

Only competitors may use the practice area. Practice from east to west only, no practice balls to be hit towards Clubhouse.

10. THE USE OF GOLF CARTS IN COMPETITION

The use of motorised golf buggies during all competitions is permitted under Rule 33-1/8.

11. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES (DMD)

The use of distance-measuring devices for the purpose of assessing distance only is permitted, strictly in accordance with Rule 14-3.

12. STRIPS ON 7th FAIRWAY

The two narrow strips on the 7th Fairway to be treated as Fairway.

13. PLUGGED BALLS

Through the green a ball that is embedded in its own pitch-mark in the ground may be lifted, and without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay but not nearer the hole. The ball when dropped must first strike a part of the course through the green.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES:
Match Play – Loss of Hole;
Stroke Play – Two Strokes.
